38-minute lesson plan

0-4 min**Hook**

Mime, point or show a picture. Learners guess and repeat.

4-10 min**Teach**

Show the six flashcards. Say each word and learners repeat.

10-16 min**Point to...**

Lay cards on the board. Learners point and say the word.

16-23 min**Label and match
body parts**

Pairs complete page 5. Check aloud together.

23-32 min**Simon Says**

Use page 7. The teacher is Simon. Only follow an instruction when it starts with Simon says. If learners move after an instruction without Simon says, they sit out for one turn, then rejoin. Let a confident learner become Simon.

32-37 min**Write and say**

Learners write the six words and practise the model language.

37-38 min**Exit check**

Each learner names one card or gives the model answer.

Lesson plan notes

Prepare the activity

Print page 7 and cut out the caller cards if needed. The teacher is Simon. Only follow an instruction when it starts with Simon says. If learners move after an instruction without Simon says, they sit out for one turn, then rejoin. Let a confident learner become Simon.

Differentiation

Support: keep the flashcards visible and let learners point before speaking. Stretch: learners ask the question without reading it and become the caller or leader.

Why this game works

The activity repeats all six words in short, meaningful turns. It also gives every learner repeated practice with: Simon says touch your _____. / Touch your _____.
