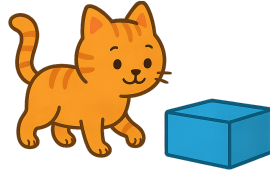
How to play Map Walk

38-minute lesson plan

0-4 min**Hook**

Mime, point or show a picture. Learners guess and repeat.

4-10 min**Teach**

Show the six flashcards. Say each word and learners repeat.

10-16 min**Point to...**

Lay cards on the board. Learners point and say the word.

16-23 min**Classendo Travel
Routes Wordsearch**

Learners find and circle the six route words in the medium grid with filler letters, then say each one aloud.

23-32 min**Map Walk**

Use page 7. Lay the six cards out as a simple map. Learners follow a partner's route instructions, walk to each card in order, and then explain the route to a new partner.

32-37 min**Write and say**

Learners write the six words and practise the model language.

37-38 min**Exit check**

Each learner names one card or gives the model answer.

Lesson plan notes

Prepare the activity

Print page 7 and cut out the caller cards if needed. Lay the six cards out as a simple map. Learners follow a partner's route instructions, walk to each card in order, and then explain the route to a new partner.

Differentiation

Support: keep the flashcards visible and let learners point before speaking. Stretch: learners ask the question without reading it and become the caller or leader.

Why this game works

The activity repeats all six words in short, meaningful turns. It also gives every learner repeated practice with: Where do you go? / Go ____.
