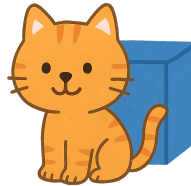
How to play

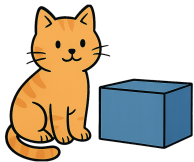

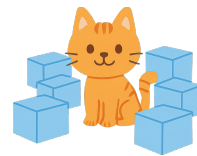

38-minute lesson plan

0-4 min**Hook**

Mime, point or show a picture. Learners guess and repeat.

4-10 min**Teach**

Show the six flashcards. Say each word and learners repeat.

10-16 min**Point to...**

Lay cards on the board. Learners point and say the word.

16-23 min**Classendo Where Things Are Tic-Tac-Toe**

Partners play all four boards. On each turn, say the preposition correctly before writing X or O. Three in a row wins each board.

23-32 min**Find the Object**

Use page 7. Set the six cards at picture stations. Learners walk to a station, point, and say the full answer. They then find a partner at a different station, ask the question, and swap places.

32-37 min**Write and say**

Learners write the six words and practise the model language.

37-38 min**Exit check**

Each learner names one card or gives the model answer.

Lesson plan notes

Prepare the activity

Print page 7 and cut out the caller cards if needed. Set the six cards at picture stations. Learners walk to a station, point, and say the full answer. They then find a partner at a different station, ask the question, and swap places.

Differentiation

Support: keep the flashcards visible and let learners point before speaking. Stretch: learners ask the question without reading it and become the caller or leader.

Why this game works

The activity repeats all six words in short, meaningful turns. It also gives every learner repeated practice with: Where is it? / It is ____.
